It is a thrill—and a relief—to once again be planning a full season of beautiful choral concerts for your enjoyment! This year our programs will include many wonderful discoveries as we catch up from missed opportunities during the pandemic lockdown.

The season opens with a celebration of the patron saint of musicians, St. Cecilia. We will present the world premiere of a major work by yours truly, A Song for St. Cecilia, which sets the 1687 poem by John Dryden as a cantata for chorus, organ, and percussion. Excerpts from Henry Purcell's Hail, Bright Cecilia, composed in 1692, offer a different take on her life and work. Rounding out the program will be Antonín Dvořák's Te Deum, in my own arrangement for chamber ensemble. We will be giving only two performances of this concert program, on December 2nd & 3rd. Don't miss it!

Our March and June programs will examine current trends in choral composition. *Global Harmony*, the first weekend of March, 2023, includes a diverse array of pieces by 21st-century composers from around the world. A featured work is by Hanna Havrylets, an award-winning Ukrainian composer who tragically lost her life during a bombing in the first weeks of the Russian invasion. Music from other European countries as well as Asia and South America will contribute to our efforts to draw on music as a means to unite the world.

The success of our Pacific Passions program in 2011, featuring unaccompanied contemporary choral works by West Coast composers, prompted my desire to revisit and expand upon the theme this year. This updated program will include piano accompaniment to expand our options and will feature both old friends and new names from artists living in California, Oregon and Washington.

Please join us as we delight in many musical discoveries during our 44th season!

Four years ago, Sanford Dole composed a major work setting John Dryden's 1687 poem, A Song for St. Cecilia for orchestra, symphonic choir, and soloists, but the scale of the work made it challenging to present. This year he created a chamber version for organ, piano, and percussion, and we're excited we can finally share it with you!

Also on the program are excerpts from Henry Purcell's Hail, Bright Cecilia, which sets a different ode to our favorite saint, and the grand Te Deum by Antonín Dvořák in a chamber version Sanford created especially for this concert.
